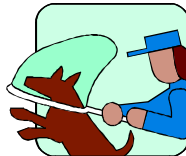

## PET LICENSE RENEWAL

Annual dog and cat license renewals in the City are due on May 1, 2009. A license is required for any dog or cat that is 6 months of age or older. There is a limit of 3 dogs and/or 3 cats six months of age or older per household. You may purchase your animal license through the Halstead City Clerk's office. Hours are Monday through Friday 8 A.M. until 5 P.M. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required for purchase of animal license.

Dogs/Cats = \$10.00

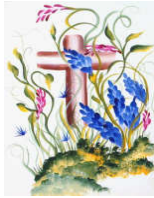
If spayed/neutered = \$4.00

To allow the cemetery to be mowed for the Memorial Day holiday, all faded flowers and non-permanent containers will be removed. After Memorial Day, regular summer mowing will resume June 15, and all decorations must be removed prior to that time.

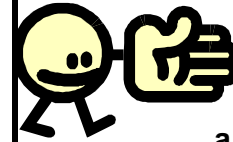
