Tuesday, May 26 LEAF, LIMB, and GRASS PICK-UP DAY

The City Maintenance crew will make a *one-time only* curbside pass through the residential area to pick-up leaves, limbs, and grass clippings.

1. Leaves & grass clippings must be in plastic bags.
2. Limbs must be cut 15' or less in length.
3. All yard waste must be at the curb in front of the residence by 8:00 am on Tuesday, May 26.
4. **REGULAR TRASH AND GARBAGE WILL NOT BE PICKED UP ON THIS DAY.**



PET LICENSE RENEWAL



Annual dog and cat license renewals in the city are due on May 1, 2009. A license is required for any dog or cat that is 6 months of age or older. There is a limit of 3 dogs and/or 3 cats of 6 months of age or older per household. You may purchase your pet license through the Halstead City Clerk's office. Hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required for purchase of animal license.

Annual City pet license fees are as follows:

Dogs/Cats	\$10.00
If spayed/neutered	\$4.00
Late Charge	\$5.00
(applied after May 31, 2009)

Annual Notice to Wastewater System Users

The minimum monthly user charge for normal domestic wastewater is \$21.84 for the first 5,000 gallons of water consumed plus \$1.09 per 1,000 gallons thereafter. Amounts in excess of 50,000 gallons shall be billed an additional \$1.09 per 1,000 gallons. For residential contributors, water usage is based on the average of the January, February, and March billings. For industrial and commercial contributors, water usage is based on the actual water consumption during the current billing month.
