GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE FOURTH OF JULY

Fireworks may be sold and discharged on:
July 3rd & 4th between the hours of 8:00 AM and 11:59 PM

Have a SAFE & FUN 4th !!

- * It is unlawful to:
 - discharge any fireworks within 50' of any gasoline pump or storage area, hospital, or nursing home.
 - throw fireworks in the direction of any animal, person(s), or vehicles or throw from any vehicle.
- * **Bottle rockets are prohibited!**
- * It's a good idea to have a source of water close at hand!
- * Don't carry firecrackers around in your pocket (think of the pain...)
- * Use parental supervision!
- * Watch out for the little kids!
- * Don't set fireworks off near your pets!
- * Permission from the property owner is required to discharge fireworks on private property!
- * **Help keep Halstead clean - please pick-up your trash after shooting fireworks!**
