

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLE AND TRASH GUIDELINES

RECYCLE - Stutzman Refuse Disposal, Inc. (SRD)

* **Recycling is mandatory in Harvey County**

* Pick-up is every other Friday (see calendar on reverse side)

* Stutzman Refuse Disposal, Inc. is the only authorized contractor to pick up residential recycle in Halstead

* Cost is \$3.65 per month which includes 1 cart

* Items to be recycled in cart provided are:

Glass - food & beverage

Metal - aluminum beverage cans, steel/tin cans

Plastic - plastics #1 or #2

Paper - newspapers, all office paper, computer printout, magazines, phone books, catalogs, junk mail

Corrugated Cardboard

Vehicle Batteries (lead based only) - place batteries beside cart

Motor Oil (used) - use plastic containers with lids (liquid soap bottles) - seal securely & label "Motor Oil" - place beside cart



REGULAR TRASH - Waste Connections Inc. (WCI)

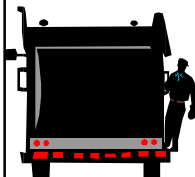
* Pick-up is every Friday (see exceptions below)

* WCI is the only contractor authorized to pick up residential trash in Halstead

* Cost is \$10.75 per month for basic service which includes 1 cart

* Citizens 65 & older qualify for Senior Rate \$8.75

* \$.60 per each additional cart



YARDWASTE - **CANNOT** be included with regular trash

* The City will provide curbside pickup of yard waste twice annually - May 26 & December 1, 2009

* Yard waste is limited to grass, leaves, limbs, branches, garden debris (excluding produce)

* May be taken to City Burns site (no fee is charged) or to Harvey County Landfill

* **Cannot be mixed in with regular trash or recycle**

* City Burns site is open 9 AM to 1 PM:

January & February - 2nd & 4th Saturdays

March through October - every Saturday

November & December - 2nd & 3rd Saturdays



RECYCLE TIPS

- Put *shredded paper* in a plastic bag & put the bag in the cart.
- *Can lids* should be placed inside *cans*, with top of can slightly flattened.
- It is not necessary to remove labels from any recycle items.
- Rinse all cans, bottles, and glass of foodstuffs before placing in recycle cart.
- *Corrugated Cardboard* should be flattened & placed in or beside cart if necessary.
- *Motor Oil* must be in labeled plastic containers with tight lids and placed beside cart.
- *Vehicle Batteries* must be placed beside cart.
- *Paper towels and napkins* should be placed with regular trash.
- **NO aluminum foil or pie plates.**
- **NO clothing.**
- **NO styrofoam.**

Place recycle cart curbside, a short distance from trash, by 7 am.

HAZARDOUS WASTE needs to be taken to Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility, 3205 SW 24th, Newton, KS (on the south side of road just west of Cow Palace Rd, 1 mile south of US HWY 50).

Items they will take are paints & paint-related products, pesticides, household products containing organic solvents, ignitables, & aerosols. Their hours of operation are 8 am to 5 pm.
