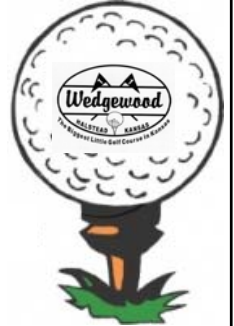
## MOWING REMINDER

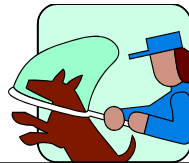

## PET LICENSE RENEWAL

Annual dog and cat license renewals in the City are due on May 1, 2010. A license is required for any dog or cat that is 6 months of age or older. There is a limit of 3 dogs and/or 3 cats six months of age or older per household. You may purchase your animal license through the Halstead City Clerk's office. Hours are Monday through Friday 8 A.M. until 5 P.M. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required for purchase of animal license.

For your convenience, the City Clerk's office will remain open until 7 P.M. on Monday, May 17.

Annual City animal license fees are :

Dogs/Cats = \$10.00

If spayed/neutered = \$4.00

Late Charge = \$5.00 (applied after May 31, 2010)

### RECYCLING TIPS



Items that are not accepted and need to be placed in trash are:

- Plastic Bags
- Shredded Paper
- Styrofoam
- Aluminum Foil or Pie Plates
- Clothing

Recycle items are to be placed, loose, directly into the cart. . . . EXCEPT FOR the following items which are to be placed beside the cart:

- Motor Oil - must be in labeled plastic containers with tight lids.
- Vehicle Batteries



- Place recycle cart curbside by 6 am. on pickup day.
- Cart should be placed approximately 4' from trash cart, vehicles, or any other object so it is easily visible and accessible to the truck driver.
