GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE FOURTH OF JULY

Fireworks may be sold: 8:00 AM to 11:59 PM, July 2 & 3
12 noon to 11:59 PM, July 4

Fireworks may be discharged from 8:00 AM to 11:59 PM, July 2, 3, & 4

- * It is unlawful to:
 - discharge any fireworks within 50' of any gasoline pump or storage area, hospital, or nursing home.
 - throw fireworks in the direction of any animal, person(s), or vehicles or throw from any vehicle.
- * **Bottle rockets are prohibited!**
- * It's a good idea to have a source of water close at hand!
- * Don't carry firecrackers around in your pocket (think of the pain...)
- * Use parental supervision!
- * Watch out for the little kids!
- * Don't set fireworks off near your pets!
- * Permission from the property owner is required to discharge fireworks on private property!
- * **Help keep Halstead clean - please pick-up your trash after shooting fireworks!**

TRASH & RECYCLE REMINDERS

To insure pickup, have trash & recycling curbside by 6 AM each Friday.

Place recycle cart curbside, approximately 4' from any other object. Cart must face forward and cannot be behind any object (car, mailbox, tree, pole, etc.)
