

## SINGLE STREAM RESIDENTIAL RECYCLE

Stutzman Refuse Disposal, Inc. (SRD)

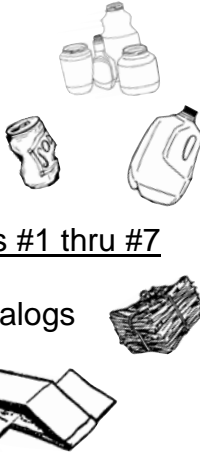
### Recycling is mandatory in Harvey County

Pick-up is every other Friday (see calendar on reverse side)

Cost is \$3.65 per month which includes 1 cart

Items to be recycled in cart provided are:

- ✓ Glass food & beverage jars & bottles (all colors)
- ✓ Aluminum & steel beverage & food cans
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans
- ✓ Plastic beverage, food & soap containers #1 thru #7
- ✓ Magazines, newspapers (with inserts), junk mail, office paper, phone books, catalogs
- ✓ Corrugated Cardboard (cut, flattened and placed in cart)



Outside of cart:

- ✓ Vehicle Batteries (lead based only)
- ✓ Used Waste Oil in a sealed container & labeled "Waste Oil"

### TRASH - Waste Connections Inc. (WCI)

- \* Pick-up is every Friday (see exceptions below)
- \* Cost is \$11.00 per month for basic service which includes 1 cart
- \* \$.60 per each additional cart
- \* Citizens 65 & older qualify for Senior Rate \$9.00



### YARD WASTE - CANNOT be included with regular trash

- \* The City will provide curbside pickup of yard waste twice annually - June 1 & November 29, 2011
- \* Yard waste is limited to grass, leaves, limbs, branches, garden debris (excluding produce)
- \* Yard waste may be taken to City Burnsite (no fee is charged) or to Harvey County Landfill
- \* **Yard waste cannot be mixed in with regular trash or recycle**
- \* City Burnsite is open 9 AM to 1 PM:  
January through October - every Saturday  
November & December - 2nd & 3rd Saturdays



## MATERIAL NOT ACCEPTED IN RECYCLE PROGRAM

- Plastics, Glass, & Metals not listed  
Aluminum Foil or Pie Plates  
Styrofoam  
Plastic Bags  
Paint Cans  
Clothing  
Hazardous Chemical Containers  
Shredded Paper

### RECYCLE TIPS

- All items should be placed loose in cart. No plastic bags.
- Rinse all cans, bottles, and glass of foodstuffs before placing in recycle cart.
- Can lids should be placed inside cans, with top of can slightly flattened.
- Labels do not need to be removed from any recycle items.
- Paper towels and napkins should be placed with regular trash.

Place recycle cart curbside, approximately 4' from any other object, by 6 am.
